ABOUT ADOPT-A-COP MINISTRY

Adopt-A-Cop is a prayer ministry that covers our communities' Law Enforcement officers with prayer daily.

Besides the obviously high physical risk in their profession, officers also have a higher probability of becoming cynical, feeling hopeless, having relationship problems, succumbing to alcohol abuse, drug abuse, involved in domestic violence and becoming suicidal. The divorce and suicide rates among law enforcement personnel far exceed the national average.

While a bulletproof vest affords a certain level of protection for our officers, an even greater blessing and shield of protection can be found in the power of prayer.

The goal of Adopt-A-Cop is to assign every individual officer to a person or family who will pray for them daily and send an occasional note offering encouragement, prayer support and gratitude for the service they provide.

Imagine the difference YOU can make in the lives of those who put their lives on the line for us every day.

ADOPT-A-COP MINISTRY REQUIREMENTS

PRAYER PARTNERS

We ask that an Adopt-A-Cop Prayer Partner commit to praying for an individual law enforcement officer every day. Please do not contact your assigned officer except through notes or letters sent to the agency address of the law enforcement officer. The notes are to serve as a means of encouragement and appreciation only. You may include Scriptures if you desire. Please do not attempt to evangelize or preach. We are providing prayer coverage and support only. We ask that you do not send tracts or gifts of any kind with your note.

OFFICERS

If you are a law enforcement officer and would like to receive support, encouragement and prayer for your work, we invite you to submit your information to the Adopt-A-Cop website. The ministry will assign your name to a committed prayer partner. If possible, this will be a person who lives in your area.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How Do I Participate in Adopt-A-Cop as a Law Enforcement Officer or Prayer Partner? Go to Adopt-A-Cop.org and click on "Get Involved"!

How do I contact my Cop?

The officer decides how you contact him or not. Always remember that your prayers are not based on your contact with your officer. Your prayers are based on your relationship with God

But you can contact your officer through prayer cards and notes of encouragement sent directly to the department unless the law enforcement officer initiates the communication. There is to be no solicitation of any kind.

Is it necessary to sign our names?

Sure, you may, but the officers don't need your address, phone number or email. If they would like to respond, they may contact an Adopt-A-Cop office and they will be happy to provide them the information they need.

May I buy or make my own cards?

Yes, you may, but we ask that you do not include anything in the envelope except the card.

What do I do with my completed Adopt-a-Cop cards?

We ask that you mail them directly to the Law Enforcement agency of which your officer serves.
